STAR2

What is STAR2?

STAR2 stands for Skin Tightening and Rejuvenation. It is a treatment that utilises Sciton's Skintyte2 (the upgraded version of the previous Skintyte technology) and Broadband Light (BBL). Skintyte2 delivers heat into the dermis, stimulating

collagen production and minimising the appearance of pores and fine lines, while BBL uses light of different wavelengths to target imperfections of the skin such as acne scars, pigmentation, freckles and rosacea.



Which areas can be treated with STAR2?

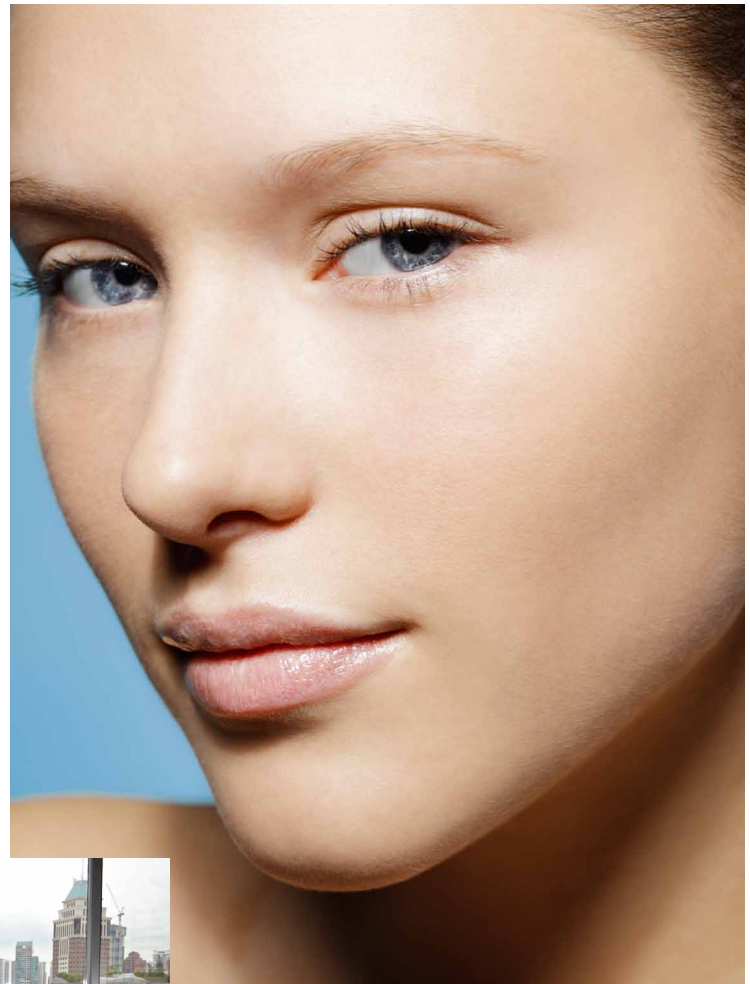
Any part of your body can be treated, but commonly treated areas are those that appear saggy or have lost their natural collagen and elastic fibres, and areas which have been exposed to the damaging effects of sunlight. These include the face, neck, hands, under the arms and abdomen.

How many treatments does one need?

Typically, four to five treatments are recommended with four to five weeks in between each of them. For most patients, skin feels tightened and appears considerably lifted after only one treatment.

What happens during the procedure?

A numbing cream is applied to the areas that are to be treated. Before



the procedure begins, your eyes are covered with safety shields. It is normal to feel a slight warming sensation as the heat and light are absorbed by the targeted areas.

What should one expect after STAR2?

Areas with pigmentation may appear slightly darker but this will gradually fade over several days. Some redness in the treated areas may also be visible. This will subside within several hours.

What post-treatment care is required?

As the treated areas will be sensitive to UV radiation, it is important to apply sunscreen regularly and avoid direct sun exposure until the areas have completely healed.

How does one maintain the results?

STAR2 can be done every four to six months as maintenance. A good skincare regimen is also necessary. One recommended product is the Rejuvenation Essence from our LE Timeless range.
